Metropolitan Youth Sports Leagues (MYSL) has implemented the following Player's Code of Conduct for all youth participants in our leagues. Players should read, understand and sign this form and let it guide them as they participate in practices, games, and events.

I pledge to be responsible for my participation by following the Player Code of Conduct of Metropolitan Youth Sports:

1. I agree to always practice good sportsmanship, to win without bragging, lose without excuse and never quit.
2. I agree to attend and participate in all scheduled games and practices when reasonably possible and to notify my coach in advance if I am unable to attend.
3. I will never throw equipment in anger and I agree to be aware of all safety rules and will follow team and league rules to ensure safe play.
4. I agree to my coach's authority and will participate and communicate positively with my coach, teammates and other staff.
5. I agree to treat fellow players, opponents, coaches, officials, fans with respect.
6. I agree to exercise self-control at all times, refraining from foul language and setting a positive example for others to follow.
7. I agree to support and encourage my teammates, to always try my best and to keep a positive attitude.
8. I will adhere to all rules and regulations set forth in the MYF Member handbook and MYF Technology handbook.
