Metropolitan Youth Sports Leagues (MYSL) has implemented the following Coaches' Code of Conduct for all coaches in our leagues. Coaches should read, understand and sign this form and let it guide them in their interactions with our student athletes.

I therefore agree:

1. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of my personal desire to win.
2. I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
3. I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for all players.
4. I promise to review and practice the basic first aid principles needed to treat injuries of my players.
5. I will use the practice plan mandated by MYSL.
6. I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship.
7. I will do my part to ensure a sports environment that is free from profanity, weapons, drugs, alcohol, and tobacco and will help to prohibit their use at all events.
8. I will maintain my knowledge of the rules of each sport I coach and will teach the rules to my players.
9. I will never ridicule or yell at a player for making a mistake or losing a competition.
10. I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
11. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront fellow coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
12. I will adhere to all rules and regulations set forth in the MYF Volunteer handbook and MYF Technology handbook.
